CODE OF CONDUCT

To maintain a high level of safety and a feeling of respect and camaraderie, please ensure that your family follows the code of conduct:

- All participants must wear wristbands at all times;
- All children must be accompanied by an adult;
- Sneaking in or inviting unregistered persons into the campout will result in forfeiting early registration status for the following year;
- Please help keep the grounds clean by picking up your trash;
- Alcohol and tobacco (including vaping) are not allowed and are prohibited by Sections 38.006 and 37.122 of the Texas Education Code;
- Anyone who is clearly under the influence of alcohol will be sent home and will forfeit their early registration status for the following year:
- Respect tent boundaries and do not enter others' tents without prior permission;
- Campers are not allowed to leave the camp area without being accompanied by a parent or responsible adult;
- No costumes are allowed, including (but not limited to) costume masks and morphsuits;
- No weapons (real or pretend) are allowed, including (but not limited to) nerf guns and toy swords;
- No bikes or skateboards should be used throughout the campus;
- No stealing*; No fighting or physical altercations*;
- No generators
- If a child is caught stealing or assaulting another child, (s)he will be required to leave the Fathers & Flashlights campout immediately, his/her family will forfeit access to "Returning Camper" early registration, and no refund will be provided.

Fathers & Flashlights strongly discourages participants from bringing valuables (TVs, computers, iPads, etc.) to the campout.
